Safety of the public and our crews is our #1 concern. We urge you to find alternate travel routes until construction is complete. Estimated completion date is July 31st, 2012.

Excavation to widen the existing road continues. Curbing and sidewalks are being poured along the eastern portion of the roadway. Most of the utilities have been

located and installed. All traffic is shifted to the south while the northern two lanes are being constructed.

Pioneer Park and Rotary Park parking lots have been graded and curbing is in. Both of these parking lots are currently dirt and will be paved during February if weather permits. These parking lots will be temporarily closed at various times throughout the next two months. Use Pioneer Loop and the Pioneer Hills Trailhead parking lots as alternates.
