

The newest Water Efficiency Rebate is now available to all City of St. George Water Services Customers

This Rebate Targets Outdoor Water Use Specifically

Is the water pressure to your irrigation system too high, misting your lawn and evaporating into the air rather than putting water droplets on the lawn that soak into the soil?

You may need a Pressure Regulating Valve (PRV) on the irrigation system. City of St. George water customers can now receive a rebate on the purchase and professional installation of a PRV for the irrigation system.

The rebate amount is based on the size of the irrigation line and where the PRV is purchased.

- ◆ PRV's sized for ¾ inch and 1 inch lines are eligible for a rebate of 50% of the cost up to \$35.
- ◆ PRV's sized for 2 inch lines are eligible for a rebate of 50% of the cost up to \$150.

Customers may receive a larger rebate if the PRV is purchased from a supplier physically located within the City of St. George and holding a valid City business license. The rebate amounts are as follows:

- ◆ PRV's sized for ¾ inch and 1 inch lines are eligible for a rebate of 50% of the cost up to \$45.
- ◆ PRV's sized for 2 inch lines are eligible for a rebate of 50% of the cost up to \$175.

Additionally, if the installation is professionally done, a rebate of \$25 is available. For those that install the PRV themselves, there is no rebate for the installation.

This program is open to all water customers, residential or commercial. Home Owner Associations may apply. However, if your system requires more than one PRV, please contact René Fleming before purchase to determine if you will be eligible for a rebate for more than one PRV.

Program start date is September 21, 2011 through June 30, 2013 or funds are depleted, whichever occurs first.
