



BLUFF STREET ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

PUBLIC MEETING

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT), in coordination with the City of St. George and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), has prepared an Environmental Assessment (EA) for Bluff Street, from St. George Boulevard to Red Hills Parkway. The build alternative includes:

- Widening Bluff Street to seven lanes—three travel lanes each direction with a center turn lane—from St. George Boulevard to 500 North
- A jug-handle underpass intersection at Bluff Street and Sunset Boulevard
- A median U-turn intersection at Bluff Street and St. George Boulevard
