To be eligible for the program customers must meet certain requirements:

1. Be an existing City of St. George residential customer in good standing.
2. Replace an existing high use toilet with a model from the approved list.
3. Submit the completed application with a purchase receipt to the address listed on the application.

To be an effective water conservation program it must result in long term water savings.

The Ultra Low Flow Toilet Rebate program is a City of St. George program. It is effective from April 1, 2006 through March 31, 2008. The City of St. George reserves the right to cancel or modify the program during that time. Rebates are offered independently of any sale price or rebates that may be concurrently offered by manufacturers or vendors.

An effective program must also meet customers satisfaction expectations.

To meet both of these criteria the program specifies that the rebate will be approved if the application meets three specifications.

1. An older (pre-1995) toilet must be replaced with a low flow model.
2. The toilet model must be on the list of "approved" models.
3. Applicant must be an existing City of St. George residential water utility customer.

To be approved the toilet model must have passed the independent Maximum Performance Testing (MaP). Models that have been tested and approved are proven to flush at least 250 grams of waste using 2.0 gallons per flush (gpf) or less of water. Additionally these toilets use 2.0 gpf or less with a standard replacement flapper or have been designed with a specific flapper or flush design that uses less than 2.0 gpf.
