The Youth City Council is a replica of the St. George City Council, but administered by the youth of our community. The Advisory Board will select a Mayor, City Manager, Recorder, Communications Director, Historian, Recreation Director and a Service Director based on the applicants application and interview. An Executive Council will be comprised of one representative from each class (i.e. Senior Rep, Junior Rep, Sophomore Rep and a Freshman Rep). Everyone will be involved in committees and will be personally involved in the direction that the council takes.

Interviews will be scheduled from September 1 – 8 and Acceptance Letters will be sent out on September 12th. The first Executive Council Meeting and Orientation will take place September 15th.

THIS IS A SERIOUS COMMITMENT!

Please understand that the Youth City Council is a prestigious organization and requires your full commitment. Meetings will be held every other Thursday and the Executive Council will meet once a month. The dates and times will be determined after the Executive Council is formed. There will be some changes to this as conflicts with school schedules and holidays arise. Be flexible! There will be at least one additional project during the month that will require your time and service. There will be leadership conferences, and additional service opportunities and activities as approved and planned by the council. These are sure to enrich your experience on the council. If you serve on the executive council, be aware that there will be additional planning meetings and responsibilities involved. Generally speaking your time commitment will be approximately 6-10 hours or less a month but we need everyone's help as we take on BIG PROJECTS!
