

St.George ENCROACHMENT PERMITS

If your special event requires the barricading or closure of any sidewalks or roads, you must apply for an Encroachment Permit.

TITLE 7 – PUBLIC WAYS AND PROPERTY CHAPTER 1 - STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC WAYS <u>7-1-7: OBSTRUCTIONS</u>:

A. Sidewalks And Streets: It shall be unlawful for any person, without a permit issued by the city encroachment officer, to cause an encroachment or obstruction upon any street, alley or sidewalk of the city, which shall hinder the free travel of pedestrians, automobiles or other traffic along the streets or sidewalks, or which shall obstruct the view1 along the same.
