 - * Blaster must follow the International Fire Code 2018 Edition, and the National Fire Code Standards (NFPA)#495.
 - * Blasting permit must be obtained at least two (2) business days prior to blast.
 - * A copy of the site safety plan will be attached to this permit.
 - * The St. George Fire Department shall be contacted one (1) hour prior to the event at (435)627-4150.*
