**FROM US:** The Parks and Community Events Department strives to offer the absolute best summer experience to our residents and summer visitors. It is our goal to provide and promote community health and well-being through fun and positive recreational experiences.

#### **SUMMER CAMP POLICIES:**

**Registration:** Registration is accepted on a first come, first served basis until the program is filled, or until the program deadline date, whichever comes first. Online registration is taken at https://stgeorgerecreation.activityreg.com

**Waitlist:** There is no fee to be placed on a camp waitlist. If a spot becomes available in the desired program, the participant's parent/guardian will be notified.

**Transfers:** A transfer from one camp to another camp is contingent upon availability of spots within the desired program. All registration fee differences must be paid in full prior to the start of the transfer camp. If the new program registration fee is less than the original, a credit will be issued.

**Program Cancellation & Refund Policy:** The department will issue a full refund if the department cancels a program. Cancellations for a program must be requested a minimum of 2 weeks in advance from the respective camp week start date to receive a 100% refund; credits may be issued but subject to Division Program Supervisor. No refunds or credits will be issued once or after the respective camp has begun.

\*Parents/legal guardians will be required to fill out a waiver before a child is allowed to participate in any camp or class. SOME camps require additional waiver packets (health, camp rules, and liability forms). All packets must be completed prior to the first day of camp. 
